
MEDIA MONITORING REPORT

Key Area: Health

Although January and February had more news stories covering Health Governance than the other two key areas, this effect became highly amplified in March with over 50% of all governance news revolving around issues surrounding the Covid-19 pandemic. Topics included vaccines procurement, deployment, speculation on future lockdown directives, and stories covering newer strains of the Coronavirus.

Key Area: Education



March 2021's news coverage in the Education sector constituted 26% of total articles monitored, down from February's 33%. This dip can be largely attributed to the relatively high media attention given to developments in the Health sector, especially vaccines. Most Education sector stories were policy and institutions-based.

Key Area:

Migration

Following the trend from the previous two months of 2021, the month of March also saw relatively fewer articles on Migration coverage, constituting only 16% of the total 43 articles reviewed. Major topics included news stories highlighting labour migration reforms and newly introduced MoUs and the return of Nepali workers from abroad - especially India. Reforms required for spirants planning to re-enter the international job market were also discussed in some articles.
